RE: **Levying Millage on the 2021 Assessment Roll**

List the following item in the Metro Section of the newspaper on Monday, February 8, 2021 and again on Tuesday, February 9, 2021. To comply with Constitutional Article 7, Section 23(C) and LA R.S. 47:1705(B), this ad must be:

- Placed in a section other than the classified advertisement or legal/public notice section
- Formatted in a box with a bolded outline
- Sized to be not less than two (2) inches by four (4) inches
- Printed in bold face type for the entire ad.

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Article 7, Section 23(C) of the Constitution and R.S. 47:1705(B) that a public hearing of the East Baton Rouge Parish School Board in East Baton Rouge Parish will be held at the EBRPSS Professional Development Center, located at 3000 North Sherwood Forest Blvd, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, on Thursday, March 18, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. The public hearing will be to consider levying additional or increased millage rates without further voter approval or adopting the adjusted millage rates after reassessment and rolling forward to rates not to exceed the prior year's maximum. The estimated amount of tax revenues to be collected in the next tax year from the increased millage is \$181,099,002, and the amount of increase in taxes attributable to the millage increase is \$9,211,012.
